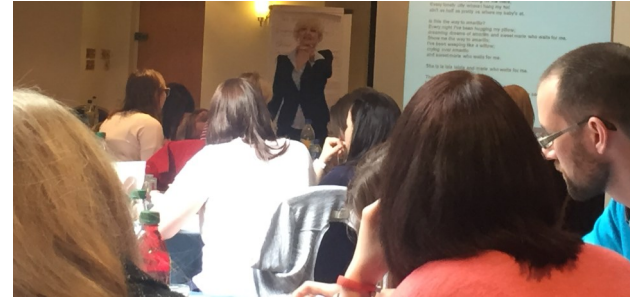

Training Routes

Tuition Fee - This route is **open to anyone** who meets the minimum eligibility criteria for teaching. You will undertake the majority of your **training in school**, but you will not be employed by the school. This route incurs a **£9,250 tuition fee** although you might be **eligible for a loan, training bursary or scholarship.**

Salaried - This is an **employment-based route** for graduates with at least three years' work experience. You will undertake the majority of your **training in school** and **earn a salary of over £16,000** while you train.

What we are looking for...

We are looking for ambitious trainee teachers who have a **passion for education**, are positive, enthusiastic, organised, creative, flexible, patient and have a desire to share these skills with young people of all abilities in the primary age range.

School Experience

We would expect all applicants to have experience of British primary schools. This could be as a volunteer or in paid work. Although there is no set amount of school experience that we require, the experience that you have got should be meaningful, relevant and significant and it should enable you to talk about learning in a range of settings. Please reflect on this experience and explain in your application form what you have learnt from it. It should also have given you an insight into the workload expectations and how highly demanding the role of a teacher is.

Skills & Qualities

We look for candidates with the following strengths:

- ◆ **Passion for learning** and an interest in/ knowledge of education
- ◆ Excellent **communication** skills (both written and verbal)
- ◆ Ability to stay **calm** and deal with stressful situations
- ◆ **Self-Motivation**, a drive to succeed and **resilience** in the face of difficulty
- ◆ Experience of working with children with **special educational needs**

- ◆ Being part of a team and **working collaboratively**
- ◆ Managing teams and other adults, holding people to account
- ◆ Sense of **fun!**
- ◆ **Reflective** practitioner who responds to feedback
- ◆ Interests outside of education
- ◆ **ICT** competent & confident
- ◆ Excellent **organisational** skills
- ◆ Willing to travel/ able to work in a range of locations
