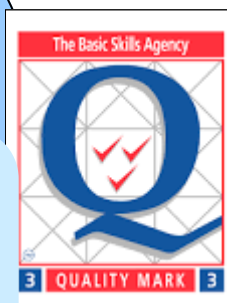

Parents Evening

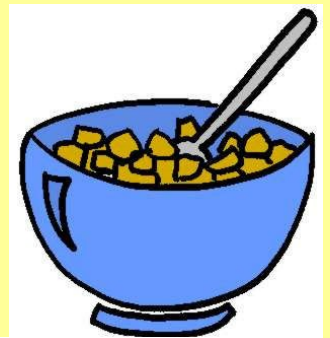

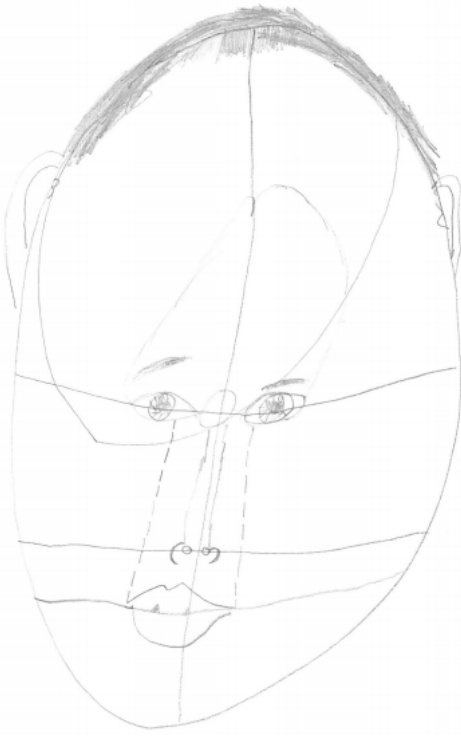

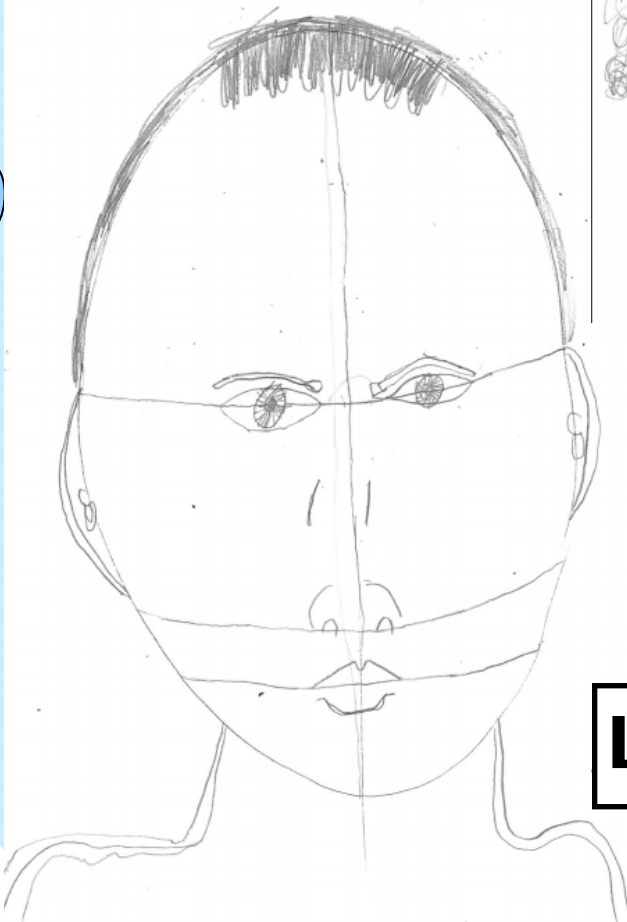
