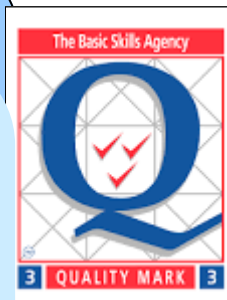
Unfortunately we will not be able to give out paper copies this year.

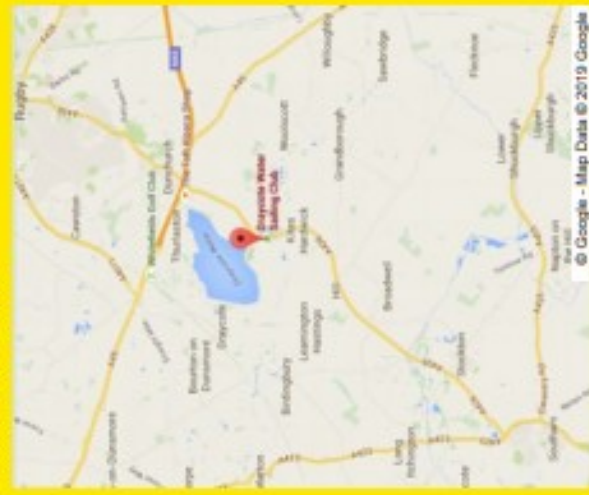
