Health Matters

As many of you are no doubt already aware, Lucien has been really poorly and after hospitalisation has been diagnosed with glandular fever. He will not be returning to school until he has been cleared to do so by the Doctor.

We have been asked to inform you that this condition is infectious and can incubate for up to 5 weeks before symptoms appear. If you or your child has any of the following symptoms, you should consult a Dr and inform them that there has been glandular fever case in school. Symptoms include sore throat, high temperature inflamed tonsils and general fatigue.



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
