You are all warmly invited to join us for our Harvest Festival Service on 7th October at 9.15.

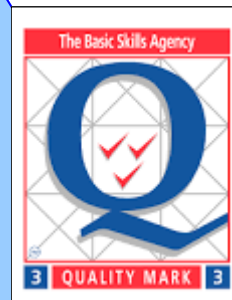
Curriculum Re-design Information/Community Engagement Consultation

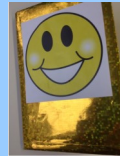

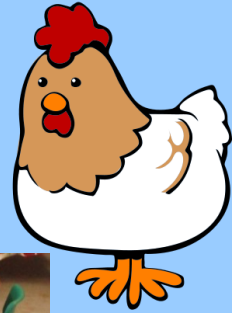


I have introduced a whole school Smile Award given by me weekly to children who have done something of which they should be proud and has made me smile.

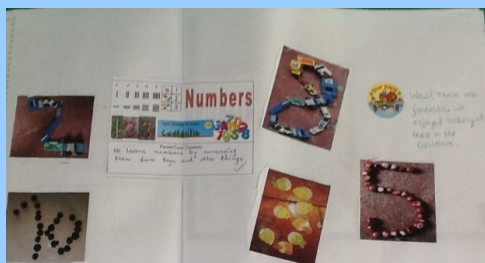
This week's first Smile went to Sera in Valkyrie.

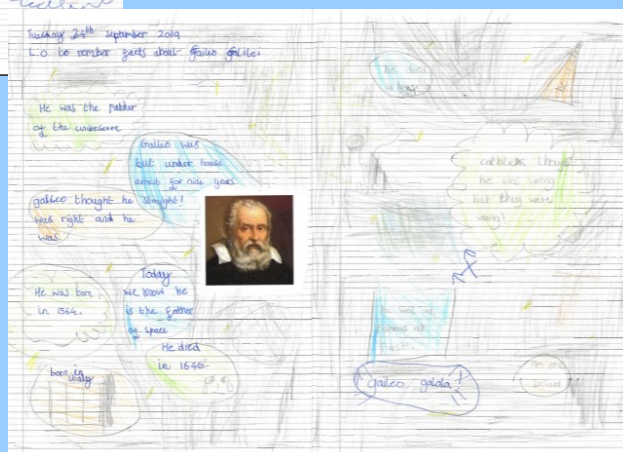
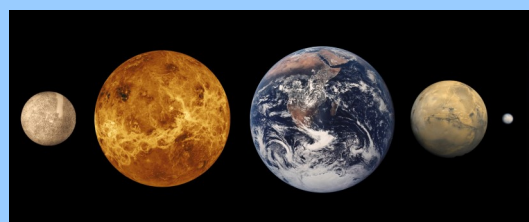


Well done to Mati in R for this super Home Learning on Number representations.
