SEND context: 5 pupils were recorded as receiving SEN Support (45.5% of the cohort); no pupils in this cohort were recorded as having an EHCP/statement.

Notes

- The combined Reading, Writing and Mathematics measure requires a pupil to meet the stated standard in all three subjects.
- Average scaled scores apply to the tested subjects of Reading and Mathematics. Writing is teacher assessed.
- Percentages are based on a cohort of 11 pupils; therefore, one pupil represents approximately 9.1 percentage points.
