




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Parents Evening


There will be a separate KS1 SATs information meeting with Mrs Munday on Thursday 19th March, 3.15-3.45.

Year 5 and 6 Assessment information meeting

On Thursday 19th March we will be holding a KS2 SATs information meeting. This will begin at 3:15 and will last no longer than half an hour. All parents and carers of children in years 5 and 6 are invited to attend this to find out more about the statutory assessments and how they can support their child at home.

Year 4 Statutory Multiplication Check

This year sees the introduction of the new times tables check (up to 12x12) for all Year 4's. The check is done on-line in school, with correct responses needed very quickly. Mrs Cox will explain more nearer the time, but meanwhile all support you can give to your child to be ready for this test will really help them succeed. Speedy recall of these facts is essential to their progress and confidence in maths. Please ask us for details of good apps and games to support your children's learning at home.
